- 1. Meeting minutes: Mirna moved to approve the May 3 minutes, 2nd by Bob; passed by consensus.
- 2. Treasurer's report: Starting balance \$381.44; \$106 was spent for PO Box. Ending balance \$275.44. Report was accepted into the record by consensus.
- 3. Green Party of CT updates: The Annual Meeting was held remotely on Saturday, May 16. Breakout sessions included sessions on Medicare for All; Community Choice Energy Aggregation; Animal Rights and Human Responsibility; and Food Justice 101. The following slate of officers was approved: Co-chairs Peter Goselin and Tim McKee, Secretary Ronna Stuller, and Treasurer Bob Stuller. There is a vacancy for the 3rd (female) co-chair position, which Tania Abbatello is seeking.

- B. Developing a "People's Budget" We agreed we should start work now on a budget proposal for 2021.
- C. Outreach and fundraising will be planned in coordination with this year's campaigns.
- 5. New Business Bud brought up the idea of a commission on renewable energy for future discussion; it seems worth researching whether the city could get sustainability points for establishing this sort of committee.
- 6. We will not have a July meeting due to the holiday weekend and conflict the following weekend with the GPUS Annual Meeting/Nominating Convention. Next meeting will be August 2.
